**Summary:** In collaboration with the HIV Services Director and the Capstone HIV Clinic Practice Manager, the Capstone Lead Physician provides medical care, leadership, and oversight of HIV clinical services for Cobb & Douglas Public Health (CDPH). The physician provides primary and HIV clinical care and is responsible for the quality of clinical care for all Capstone HIV Clinic patients. Also provides clinical support for TB clinic and will perform other duties as assigned. Essential functions include but not limited to: Clinical/Medical Responsibilities: Performs medical evaluations and makes recommendations to patients. Advises patients on health care issues including infectious diseases, health promotion, disease, illness and accident prevention. Directs and coordinates clinical activities of APRNs. Consults with and advises APRNs regarding the diagnosis and management of patients. Assists CDPH Tuberculosis Program staff with clinical patient management. Leadership Responsibilities: Participates in the development and implementation of both long- and short-term strategic and operational goals. Provides encouragement and social influence to motivate/maximize the efforts of all Capstone HIV Clinic staff toward achievement of identified strategic and operational goals. Management Responsibilities: in collaboration with and support of Capstone HIV Clinic Practice Manager and HIV Services Director oversees and supports the clinical work of physicians, APRNs, and nurses. Ensures compliance with federal and state guidelines and regulations.
