

# Ending the HIV Epidemic

## Community Advisory Board Meeting

Cobb & Douglas Public Health (CDPH) in partnership with Positive Impact Health Centers held the sixth Cobb County EHE Community Advisory Board Meeting via Zoom Communications on July 22, 2020.

Cobb & Douglas Public Health is continually monitoring and responding to the current COVID-19 pandemic. HIV Prevention, PrEP and STD services are still available at all CDPH locations.

HIV care, provided by Positive Impact, has continued while implementing a telehealth model for many services.

The Community Advisory Board discussed ways to integrate HIV testing at COVID-19 testing sites. Suggestions were made for geofencing at COVID-19 testing locations, curbside pick-up of at-home HIV test kits at the health department, and alternate locations for at home HIV test kit distribution.
