

# TRAVEL CLINICAL ASSISTANT FACTSHEET

## WHAT IS TRAVEL CLINICAL ASSISTANT (TCA)?

TCA is a web tool that provides information to the public on travel-related diseases and outbreaks that have occurred over the past 2 years. All information is confirmed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

## HOW TO ACCESS THE TCA TOOL
